The following items were discussed:

1. Request approval for a temporary sales trailer for Solis Condominium at 25802 Perdido Beach Boulevard.
2. Request approval of a 12-month extension to the Springhill Suites by Marriot Planned Unit Development, 24241 Perdido Beach Boulevard, Case No. 0103-PUD-22.
3. Resolution appropriating funds to The Zoo Foundation, Inc., to sponsor the Alabama Gulf Coast Zoo in the amount of \$50,000 for FY2023. Joel Hamilton, Zoo Executive Director, and Paula White, Zoo Director of Development, thanked the city council for their support, summarized the benefits of zoo sponsorship, and reminded city employees of the upcoming employee day at the zoo this Saturday.
4. Resolution authorizing the purchase of Archive Storage Mobile Shelving for the Administration Department through Sourcewell in the amount of \$66,023.83.

9. Resolution awarding the bid for Canoe Trail Post-Hurricane Sally Repairs.
10. Resolution awarding the bid for Perdido Pass Seawall Park Post-Hurricane Sally Repairs and Phase III Expansion.
