

RESOLUTION NO. 23-xxx

**A RESOLUTION AWARDED THE ANNUAL BID FOR
MAGNESIUM HYDROXIDE SLURRY TO
PREMIER MAGNESIA, LLC
PER UNIT PRICING FOR A MAXIMUM OF THREE YEARS**

FINDINGS:

1. Bids for Magnesium Hydroxide Slurry for use at the Orange Beach Wastewater Treatment Plant were received and opened on March 16, 2023.
2. The Utilities Department has recommended award to the lowest bid meeting specifications from Premier Magnesia, LLC. The product provided by Garrison Minerals LLC does not meet specifications due to higher than maximum viscosity and particle size which can cause feeding problems and maintenance issues if introduced into the existing system.
3. City Council finds that the lowest responsible bid was submitted by Premier Magnesia, LLC.
4. The term of the awarded contract shall be for one year starting from the date of award with the option to renew for two (2) additional one-year terms.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORANGE BEACH, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the bid for Magnesium Hydroxide Slurry, as specified by the bid documents, is awarded to Premier Magnesia, LLC;
2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to approve payment to Premier Magnesia, LLC, in the amounts as per their bid dated March 16, 2023, for Magnesium Hydroxide Slurry;
3. That this unit price purchasing agreement shall auto-renew for two (2) additional one-year terms for a maximum total of three (3) years with a final expiration date of March 15, 2026; and
4. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
