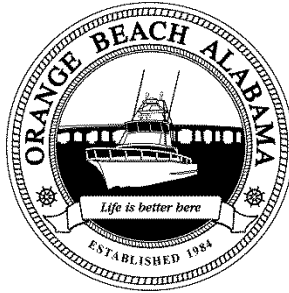

Proclamation

- Whereas,** more than 100,000 Americans and 1,200 waiting in Alabama are currently on the national transplant waiting list; and
- Whereas,** another person is added to the waiting list every nine minutes, and, on average, seventeen people die each day while waiting for a life-saving organ transplant; and
- Whereas,** the most effective way to address this health crisis is to educate and to encourage citizens to commit to the following actions: register your decision to be an organ, eye and tissue donor at legacyofhope.org or at your local DMV; and
- Whereas,** we in Orange Beach, Alabama, feel that the Donate Life cause of saving and healing lives through organ, eye and tissue donation is of such immediate and worthwhile importance that,

Now, therefore, be it proclaimed by the Orange Beach City Council and Mayor that April 2023 is

NATIONAL DONATE LIFE MONTH
